

Family Mediation Services

Our Fees (where mediation vouchers are not available to cover the cost).

As the cost of mediation is usually shared equally, with each party paying half of the cost of a mediation session we have set out the per person cost and the per couple cost below.

Costs are based on an hourly rate of £120 per person. If a mediation meeting lasts for longer than 1 ½ hours then the cost will increase based on the hourly charging rate.

Please note that we ask you to make a payment on account of £500 per person in advance of each mediation session. By prior agreement with the mediator one party may agree to pay the costs of the other party, in which case a payment on account of costs of £1,000 per couple will be required in advance of each mediation session.

If the charge for the session work and follow up work is less than £500 you will be reimbursed for the difference if there are no mediation sessions anticipated. If mediation is continuing the monies will remain on account to put towards the cost of future work.
